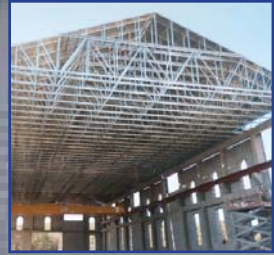

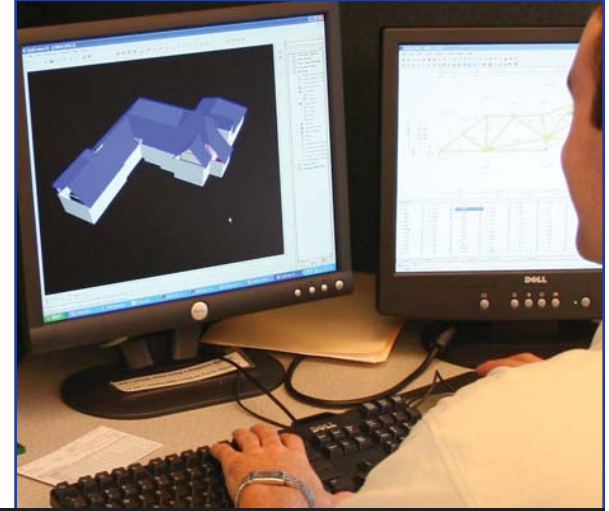
Today, structural components provide building designers and homeowners the ability to realize their dream, no matter how complicated or extraordinary their ideal house may be.

There are 2,500 structural building component manufacturing locations in the U.S., and employ over 123,000 individuals which annually manufacture and distribute products worth more than \$15 billion.

What Are Structural Building Components?

Structural building components, such as roof trusses, floor trusses, floor panels, wall panels, I-joists, and engineered beams and headers, are specialized framing pieces designed, engineered and manufactured under controlled conditions for a specific purpose. They are designed to carry their own weight, as well as that of additional loads from things like snow, wind, occupants and building materials while maintaining their original shape. This is what has allowed architects to have more freedom in their designs.



The recent growth of the structural building components industry is significant. As a result, not only is it likely a component manufacturer is located near you, chances are they're growing and looking for new employees.
